IoT4industry CALLs for collaborative projects foster the integration and the use of IoT into manufacturing sector. These calls support interregional collaborations between SMEs, large companies and research centers based in European member states or Horizon 2020 associated countries working in the industrial/manufacturing or ICT/IoT domains.

The first call closed on 20th December. About 180 companies expressed their interests and 157 proposals have been registered. Projects proposals are now to be assessed until the 14th January 2019. Selected companies will be contacted shortly after this stage and implement their project in 2019.
